Chess is a language that uses logical deductive thinking, pattern recognition, memory, and creativity. Space visualization is an art form -- watch how the knight dances circles around the ultra-straight line rook and bishop who lives only on a diagonal, and how pawns promote to the status of Queens. A 95 year old Japanese decided to develop his brain and learn Chinese -- five years later he gave a lecture in China! And some girls have now achieved the title of Chess Master before becoming a teenager.

My name is **Daniela** and I was awarded 'first category' (USCF 1900-2100 rating) and advanced to the top ten junior players in Romania. After a twenty year layoff I won the 2011 New Mexico Class B championship.

I currently work at a Montessori school and coach a chess club at Bosque School and at Cottonwood Montessori school.
